## Commemorating the End of Southern Steam

8 July to 9 September

Come and find out about the Watercress Line's flagship steam engine, *Canadian Pacific*. This fast and powerful engine was built in Eastleigh Works in 1941 by a workforce made up of male and female workers. Affectionately nicknamed *CanPac* or *CP*, she has had a fascinating 75 year life that began during the Second World War and, when restored, will continue. The restoration of this magnificent engine is part of a Heritage Lottery Fund supported project costing approximately £1.5 million.
